Terms and Conditions

By participating, you agree that:

Eligibility

You must be **18 years or older** to purchase a raffle entry. All staff, board members, committee members, and employees of Badin High School and the Archdiocese of Cincinnati (collectively, “BHS”) are eligible to participate and can win a prize in the raffle.

- Purchasers of raffle tickets must be US residents physically residing in the United States and not be precluded from participating by any governmental law or regulation.
- An affidavit of eligibility may be required from prize winners.
- **NOTE:** The purchase method may be limited based on your residency. All federal, state, and local laws and regulations apply.
- Raffle tickets are non-transferable.
- All ticket sales are final. No refunds will be made, except under the following circumstances: any payment received after the applicable entry deadline. No other refunds are available except in the exclusive discretion of BHS.

Raffle Ticket Purchases

BHS and its agents, volunteers, partners, employees, and students assume no liability for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, illegible, or undelivered entries. Entries received without proper payment will be deemed invalid and shall be disqualified immediately. All ticket purchases are non-refundable (except at BHS's discretion in the event of ineligibility).

 - Accepted credit cards are Visa, MasterCard, Discover, and American Express.
 - Physical tickets will not be given out.
 - All chances will be numbered and put into a random number generator to pull a winning name at halftime of Homecoming on October 9th, 2026.

Raffle Ticket Prices

Prices for tickets are:

- **1 ticket:** \$25
- **5 tickets:** \$100
- **10 tickets:** \$200

Drawing

The Draw Date is **Friday, October 9, 2026**, during halftime of our Homecoming Football game

- Ticket sales shall cease at 11:59 pm on October 2nd.
- In this raffle, only one ticket will win the prize, and there is no possibility of a tie.
- The winning ticket will be selected by randomly generating all tickets sold and recording the result, which will be played at halftime on Friday, October 9, 2026
- Each ticket has an equal chance of winning as the prize is drawn. A single entrant may purchase multiple tickets, and each ticket shall be entered and eligible for winning separately. Odds of winning depend on the number of eligible tickets sold.

Grand Prize

The prize winner will have thirty (30) days from the Draw Date to arrange for the pickup of their prize. The prize is a **2027 CHEVY EQUINOX**. The winner must arrange to pick up the prize—it will not be delivered. The grand prize winner may elect either (a) the vehicle prize or (b) a cash prize of \$25,000. Election must be made within ten (10) business days of notification.

If the winner chooses the cash option (\$25,000), they will receive a check for that amount within twenty-one (21) days of selection.

Additional Prizes

Two additional prizes will be drawn before the grand prize. The prizes will be \$1,000 for the third (3rd) place winner and \$2,000 for the second (2nd) place winner.

Notification of Winner

The winner need not be present to win. The winner will be notified by phone and email with the required procedures for claiming the prize.

- The winner's name will be posted at <https://www.badinhs.org/> within two (2) business days after the Draw Date.
- The winner may have up to ten (10) business days from the Draw Date to finalize the process of acquiring the prize.

- The winner's name and photo may be printed in select media, at <https://www.badinhs.org/>, and in news releases and other publicity for and from BHS.

If the winner is unable to be contacted or located after thirty (30) days from the Draw Date, the prize will be donated to BHS. Three (3) attempts will be made to contact the winning entry via phone, email, and registered mail at the contact information provided by the entry purchaser. To claim the prize, an emailed confirmation together with a photo ID will be required. An affidavit of eligibility may be required from the prize winner.

Taxes and IRS Rules

The winner is responsible for any and all federal, state, and local income or excise taxes, fees, assessments, and like charges associated with the prize. The winner will be responsible for all costs associated with the retrieval and/or delivery of their prize. The cost of the raffle ticket is not tax-deductible. Please consult your tax advisor with any questions. The winner shall cooperate in providing the necessary information for the reporting of the winnings for tax purposes. If your state has particular rules about winning/playing raffles in other states, it is the responsibility of the winner to abide by those rules/regulations. The winner is solely responsible for all federal, state, and local taxes, title fees, registration fees, license fees, insurance costs, dealer documentation fees, destination charges (if applicable), and any other costs associated with ownership, registration, and operation of the vehicle not specifically included as part of the prize. BHS reserves the right to require the winner to complete IRS Form W-9 and any other documents necessary for tax reporting purposes prior to receiving the prize. BHS may issue IRS Form 1099-MISC or any successor form as required by law.

Entrants, by participating (and winners, by accepting the prize) release BHS, the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, and each of their respective agents, staff, employees, volunteers, members, and independent contractors, and each of their respective officers, directors, partners, employees, and agents (including advertising and promotion agencies) (collectively, the "Released Parties") from any and all liability with respect to participation in the promotion and possession or use of the prize awarded.

Entrants will not hold the Released Parties responsible or liable for any or all accidents, theft, or damages resulting from their participation in this event. information collected in connection with the raffle shall be used for raffle administration, winner notification, tax reporting, and related purposes and shall be handled in accordance with applicable law.

Rules

If there is a conflict between these Rules and the laws of the State of Ohio, the laws of the State of Ohio shall govern. This Raffle is void where prohibited.

These Official Rules may not be waived, modified, or supplemented except in writing by BHS. BHS reserves the right not to proceed with the Raffle at its discretion, and in such event, an entrant's sole and exclusive remedy shall be to receive a refund of the cost of the entry, without interest.
